I am a multilingual independent arbitrator and counsel based in Paris. Over the course of my 15-year career, I have gained extensive experience in international arbitrations conducted under various rules, including ad hoc, ICC, ICSID, ISTAC, UNCITRAL, SCC and SIAC rules. My practice is particularly focused on Ukraine, Central and Eastern Europe (CEE) and Turkic regions, where I have successfully handled numerous high-stakes cases. Before establishing my practice, I developed my expertise at leading international law firms in Paris and Kyiv.

My expertise is enriched by my multicultural background and my deep understanding of various national legal systems, including English, French, Kazakh, Kyrgyz, Turkish, Ukrainian and Uzbek laws. My experience spans complex investment and commercial arbitration cases, providing me with a nuanced and cross-border perspective.
